

- As the capital of Catalunya it has a vibrant and unique culture that is all its own. Local traditions, such as human towers (castells) or the correfoc, surprise and enchant visitors. The local language, Catalan, is widely used, but everybody speaks Spanish too.
- Barcelona is rightly famous for its modernist architecture, including the famous Sagrada Familia church and other buildings by Antoni Gaudí. The medieval Ciutat Vella is a maze of old streets and buildings, including the famous Ramblas.
- Barcelona is a great place for **sport** including Barça at the Camp Nou, international sporting events at the Olympic venues or joining a local club.
- Other Barcelona highlights are the many museums, including important collections by **Picasso** and **Joan Miró**, lazing on the beach, strolling around the city streets and markets and enjoying the many bars and restaurants.
- Barcelona is well connected to the rest of Catalunya and Spain. Popular excursions include the beaches of the Costa Brava and Pyrenees mountains. Madrid is just a couple of hours away by high-speed train.

Our Teachers

QUALITY TEACHING

The age of our teachers ranges from 25 to 45, with most being between 25 and 35 years old.

All of our teachers posses a title related to teaching ELE, but we also employ teachers who have completed or who are actively working through different university courses such as journalism, Spanish philology or humanities. In addition, some teachers also have or are pursuing a Masters degree to train specifically in teaching ELE.

Oxford House is not just a language school, but also a training center for teachers. The professional development of our teachers is something very important to us, and we constantly work to improve and expand the resources and opportunities offered to our teachers to foster their development. In support of this, our classes are regularly observed by the Director of Studies and teachers are encouraged to participate in both internal and external training activities.

METHODOLOGY

The primary goal of our students is to be able to communicate effectively in a foreign language by which one of the main objectives of the classes is to provide opportunities to achieve this. Students participate in communicative activities that incorporate real-life situations to demonstrate how they need to use the language outside of class. For example, students often work in pairs or small groups and participate in role-playing games or simulations of real situations, have discussions, explain events, etc. Teachers correct and provide feedback on vocabulary, grammar and pronunciation to help them improve. Classes are taught entirely in Spanish although teachers and students can use translation when necessary and/or useful.

Teachers use a variety of materials designed for teaching: textbooks, internet and authentic materials that cater to students in each group.

Teachers also assign homework to complement classroom learning. The correction of these tasks is done in class.

THE CURRICULUM

Teachers set the content for their classes according to the needs of students, the programs established by the textbooks and the Common European Framework of Reference. The courses are designed according to the levels, needs and aspirations of the students within each classroom.

Spanish Experience

Finding your way around a new city can be daunting, so we have created a programme of **fun activities** which will help you **make new friends** and **get to know the culture** of this land of contrasts. With our "Spanish Experience" you will **practise the language** while learning about the culture of Spain and other Spanish speaking countries.





Each month we look at a different topic through **workshop activities**, **conversation**, **films** and **guided tours** with your teacher which include visits to all the main sites and the less know ones, so you really get to know this vibrant city.
